Aurora Safari Camp

Organic Arctic Glamping since 2013

Aurora Safari Camp is the world's first Arctic winter "glamping" experience, based in the Råne River valley of Swedish Lapland. This is your secluded hideaway that provides all the home comforts submerged into the Arctic wilderness, that is just as spectacular in summer. From early June to mid-July Aurora Safari Camp is lit by the glow of the midnight sun, with 24 hours of sunlight. In berry picking season from Mid-July to August, the surrounding forest becomes a foraging wonderland, and late August often sees the return of the Northern Lights.



Stays at Aurora Safari Camp are fully catered, with our hosts always on hand to ensure you have a comfortable and memorable experience. From the central dining cabin, they'll serve up freshly-cooked meals with local ingredients, and will also provide guidance with the activity equipment that is included in your stay: canoes, kayaks, paddle boards and fishing equipment. We have a wealth of bookable summer activities both on the water and back on dry land. Take a canoe tour up the river; go for a cycle through the forest; or immerse yourself in our local history, culture, and way of life in northern Sweden.







Upon your arrival at Luleå Airport, our guides will collect you for a 65-minute drive through the surrounding woodland, en route to our reception building in the Råne River Valley. Here you will be fitted with lifejackets, before for the final part of your journey to Aurora Safari Camp.

This is covered by a short boat ride with one of our hosts, across the lake to the camp. Here we'll warmly welcome you with refreshments, and check you into your Tipi Cabin.

Depending on your arrival time, you can start exploring the area and take part in the various activities we have on offer.







Stays always include access to our summer activity equipment, so you can take to the water on our canoes, kayaks and paddle boards, or try your luck with our fishing equipment. Our hosts are always happy to guide you on a trip, or simply get you started if you would like to explore the area in solitude.

Make use of our <u>Forest Sauna</u> to rejuvenate from your travels, while enjoying the sights and sounds of the woodland surrounding the camp. This traditional wood-fired sauna is equipped with a 12-volt shower and changing room.



As evening approaches, we'll have an 4-course summer feast prepared for you in the dining cabin, while you enjoy a drink on the veranda. Our menu is focused on local, seasonal produce and inspired by the traditions of northern Sweden.

After dinner, take a stroll around the forest, and sit out on the veranda for the evening to soak up the long daylight hours before retiring to your Tipi Cabin for a peaceful night in the forest.





Begin your day at Aurora Safari Camp with a hearty breakfast to fuel your adventures under the Arctic sun. Then meet with your canoe guide, with whom you'll spend the morning exploring the Råne River Valley.

Guided Canoeing Safari, including lunch (4 hours)

Let an expert lead the way as you discover the local area by canoe. Enjoy this four-hour paddle through calm waters with stunning surroundings reflecting in the water, including a stop on the banks for alfresco lunch.

Finishing up the tour back at Aurora Safari Camp, and take some time out on the dining terrace with fika.







In the afternoon, take a dip in the lake just minutes from your cabin. The Arctic waters are great for swimming, often reaching 18-25C in summer. Back on dry land, follow this with a session in the Forest Sauna.

Finish up your day with a unique dinner just across the lake a, gastronomic dinner adventure through many delicious dishes. All made from local products, served with stories and songs of the eight seasons.

Eight Seasons of Lapland' Dinner

Taste your way through the diverse local ingredients of northern Sweden that are available across the year, all the main flavors are found in the surrounding wild nature, foraged carefully and presented in dishes both traditional as well as experimental. A food experience for all senses.





After breakfast, get collected by your guide who will take you for a day trip to Europe's largest waterfall.

Storforsen Full-Day Tour, including lunch (6 hours)

A favourite hiking location for Norrbotten locals, summers at Storforsen are something to behold. The protected area offers endless possibilities to walk the trails around the waterfall, surrounded by the sound of cascading water. This full day trip allows plenty of time to explore and take in the view, and enjoy a light picnic in the sunshine on the surrounding rocks.

Return to Aurora Safari Camp for a drink on the veranda, and enjoy an alfresco 4-course dinner.



After breakfast, check out from Aurora Safari Camp and take your final morning to learn about the abundance of our forests here in the north, with a foraging tour around the surrounding wilderness.

Foraging Flavour Walk, with lunch (4 hour tour)

This is an up-close tour forest by our knowledgeable guide, where you can discover the bounty of local plants with delicious, nutritious and medicinal benefits. Stop for lunch in the forest, which involves a tasting of some of these local wonders.

With your new local knowledge in hand, your guide will take then you on to Luleå airport for departure.

Please note that the foraging tour ends at approximately 14:00, so you will need to book a flight that departs at 18:00 at the earliest.

Cooked breakfast and lunch are provided according to your activity itinerary, and each evening our chefs serve home-style dinners using ingredients and methods inspired by traditional cooking in Northern Sweden. 
